User Management

Networkfleet's user management functionality allows companies to easily assign their employees the appropriate access level to Networkfleet information.

User management functionality enables System Administrators to:

- Create additional application users
- Assign users access to one or multiple groups of vehicles
- Assign users functionality level privileges

Example: Allowing certain users to only access vehicle location data, but not diagnostics data

- Grant multiple users administrative privileges
